BOSTON – Third Sector New England Executive Director **Jonathan Spack** will be joined by leaders of Boston's nonprofit and development communities to celebrate the grand opening of new community meeting and state-of-the-art training space in the \$23MM, 123,000 square foot Nonprofit Center on **Thursday, April 6, 2006 at 3:45 p.m. at 89 South Street** in Boston's Leather District. The Center is Massachusetts' first mission-based multi-tenant facility for Bay State not-for-profit organizations.
